

Regional Literacy Networking Opportunity: Create, Implement, and Monitor Strategic Professional Development Plans Focused on Structured Literacy



The goal of this regional literacy network is to increase reading proficiency through strategic professional development plans focused on structured literacy. To build a system of instructional support for all teachers, a professional development plan is necessary. The process will include not only developing but planning for implementation of your professional development plan requirements aligned with Ohio's Dyslexia Support Laws. As a network, data collection and sharing best practices will take place.

It is recommended that districts participate in the network with their district literacy team. The team may include a curriculum director, a special education director, an instructional coach, a teacher with dyslexia certification, reading specialist, elementary and secondary teacher representatives.
