What is a Parent Mentor?

A Parent Mentor is the parent of a child with a disability employed by local education agencies and Educational Service Centers to help families and school districts by providing support, information and training services. The Ohio Department of Education provides the funds for Ohio Parent Mentor project since 1991.

Families in school districts without a Parent Mentor should contact the State Support Team Region 10 or the Family & School Facilitator through Montgomery County Educational Service Center.
